This designation is filed with the Secretary of the District or the Designated Election Official (see below). Only one such person may be designated by an owner or lessee regardless of the number of properties or lots owned by such owner or lessee. No elector shall be allowed to cast more than one vote even if the person is designated by more than one entity or even if the person is eligible as an individual and also as a designee. See Section 31-25-1203(4)(a)(IV), C.R.S.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE DESIGNATION OF ELECTOR FORM

- 1 Print the name of the person who is being designated to vote on behalf of the business entity. This is the elector.
- 2 Print the name of the Designating Entity (business entity).
- 3 The person authorized to sign on behalf of the designating business entity signs and prints name.
- 4 Print the title of the person who signed on behalf of the Designating Entity as it relates to the business entity (i.e. president, manager, partner, etc.)
- 5 Enter the effective date of the designation.
- 6 Enter the address of the property owned or leased by the Designating Entity.
- 7 Check the box to indicate if the Designating Entity is the owner or lessee of the property.
- 8 Enter the address where the elector would like the ballot to be mailed.
- 9 Enter the residence address where the elector is registered to vote in Colorado.
- 10 Enter the **year** of the elector's birth.
- 11 Enter the elector's daytime telephone number. *This is optional, but makes it easier to contact the elector if there is a question regarding elector information.*
- 12 Enter the elector's e-mail address. *This is also optional.*

File the completed Designation of Elector form with the Designated Election Official of the Colfax Business Improvement District at the address below (either in person or by mail). The form will also be accepted via e-mail or fax (see information below).

In order for a ballot to be mailed to the elector, the completed designation of elector form must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 31, 2017. To receive a ballot after October 31, 2017 and before the polls close at 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 7, 2017, the elector must submit the completed form in person at the walk-in voting location at the address listed above. All voted ballots must be returned to the Designated Election Official by 7:00 p.m. on November 7, 2017.

Important things to remember:

- Each business entity that owns or leases property within the District may designate one natural person to vote on its behalf.
- Only one person may be designated by an owner or lessee that is not a natural person of property within the District.
- All persons designated must be registered to vote in the State of Colorado.
- No one person shall be allowed to cast more than one ballot in the election, even if the person is designated by more than one entity or if the person is eligible as an individual and as a designee.
