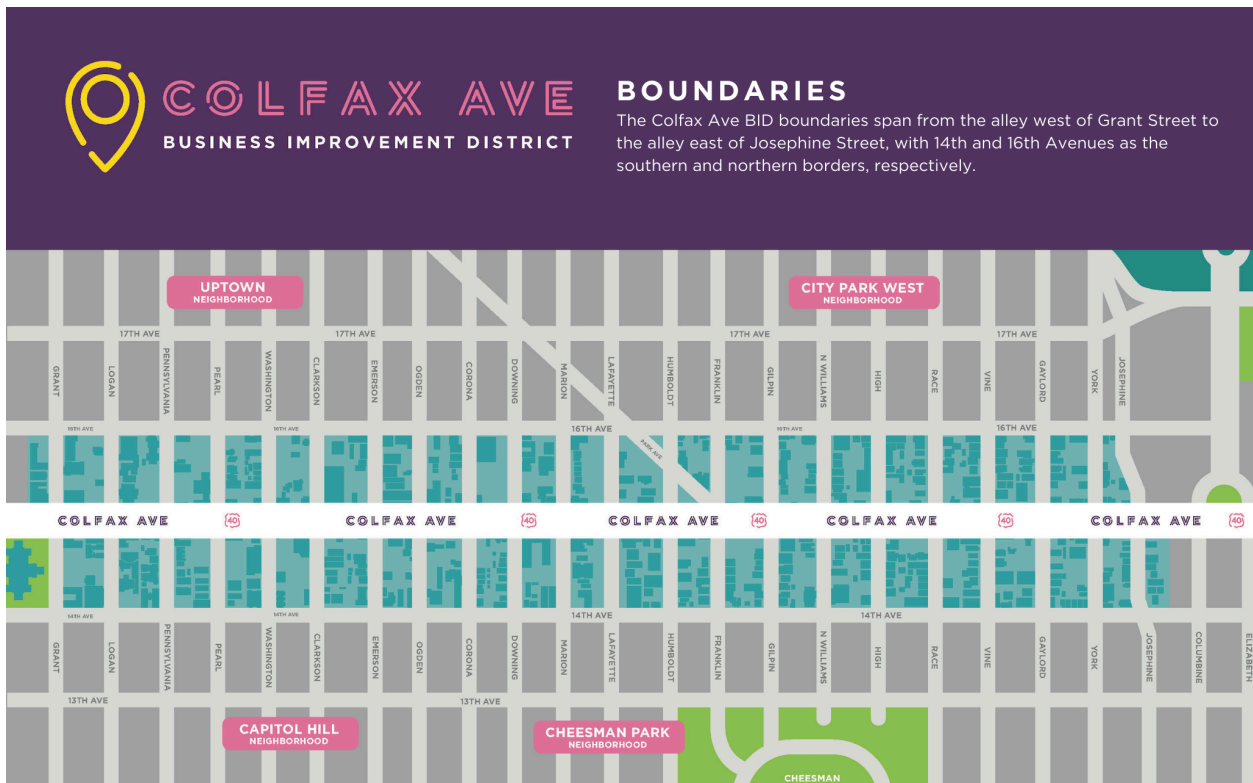


Help Guide The Future of Colfax

Apply to Become a Colfax Ave BID Board Member

The Colfax Ave Business Improvement District (BID) has a seven-member, volunteer board of directors. The board is responsible for approving the budget, priorities, and operating plan submitted to the City of Denver. Those eligible to be board members must be commercial property owners or business owners or operators that hold a lease within the boundaries of the Colfax Ave BID area. See the map below for our boundaries which span from the alley west of Grant Street to the alley east of Josephine Street, and 14th Ave on the southern border to 16th Ave on the northern border. Please apply by Wednesday, Feb. 12, and plan to attend the Tuesday, Feb. 11, board meeting at 9:15 a.m. at UMB Bank, 1635 E. Colfax Ave. At the meeting you can learn more about the board, and ask questions. Contact Frank to let him know that you will attend the meeting so we can be prepared for your attendance. Meetings are in-person only.

Board members can expect a flexible time commitment, typically requiring about three to five hours monthly. Monthly board meetings are held on the second Tuesday at 9:15 AM and usually last about two hours.

In addition, we encourage board members to participate in at least one of our four committees: Business Support, Safety, Streetscape, and Maintenance/Clean Streets. Committee meetings are held monthly and generally last an hour or less. Participation in these committees is open to anyone, regardless of whether they are a property or business owner.
